Notice of Direct Planning Application to An Bord Pleanála in respect of a Strategic Infrastructure Development

(Wexford County Council)


In accordance with section 182A of the Planning and Development Acts (as amended) Terra Solar II Limited gives notice that it proposes to seek the approval of An Bord Pleanála for a period of 10 years for development at Tullabeg, Camolin, Co. Wexford. The development comprises of a 110kV 4-bay C-type electricity substation (with 33kV customer compound) (including two control buildings, lightning protection, perimeter security fencing, security lighting, drainage infrastructure, temporary construction compound) to connect to and serve a proposed solar farm (under Wexford County Council Reg. Ref. 20191272); associated loop-in infrastructure to tie into an existing 110kV overhead transmission line including underground 110kV cabling and 2 No. new end masts with 110kV line diversion cabling; vehicular entrance and access track from public road; all associated site development works including formation of berms and landscaping.

A copy of the application may be inspected free of charge or purchased on payment of a specified fee (not exceeding the reasonable cost of making such copy) during the period from **1st November 2019 to 20th December 2019** at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 during its public opening hours and the offices of Wexford County Council, Newtown Road, Carricklawn, Wexford, Y35 WY93 during its public opening hours. Submissions and observations may be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála, accompanied by the appropriate fee of €50, during the period of 7 weeks from **1st November 2019 to 5.30pm on 20th December 2019** in relation to the implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development in the area or areas concerned and the likely effects on the environment or the likely adverse effects on the integrity of a European site, of the proposed development if carried out. Such submissions / observations must also include the following information: (i) The name of the person making the submission/observation, the name of the person acting on his/her behalf, if any, and the address to which any correspondence relating to the application should be sent; (ii) The subject matter of the submission/observation; and (iii) The reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based in full. The Board may make a decision to approve the proposed development; make such modifications to the proposed development as it specifies in the approval and approve the proposed development as so modified; approve in part only, the proposed development (with or without specified modifications of it of the foregoing kind); or refuse to approve the proposed development. The Board may at its absolute discretion hold an oral hearing on the application (For further details see 'A Guide to Public Participation in Strategic Infrastructure Development' on the Board's website www.pleanala.ie). A person may question the validity of a decision of the Board by way of an application for judicial review, under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986).
